




# Tracking the recovery

% change in job postings since Feb 01 2020, seasonally adjusted, through Mar 12th







## Pandemic might kill jobs requiring less education Projected job growth, 2019-2029, by education required



# Remote job postings on the rise heading into spring


Postings for remote work as a share of all postings, %, through Feb 28th
